

Article I: Name

The name of the Association shall be Delta Daylily Society, Inc. It is an affiliated member of the American Hemerocallis Society.

Article II: Object

Delta Daylily Society, Inc. shall be a non-profit organization whose purpose is to promote, encourage, and foster the development and improvement of the genus Hemerocallis and public interest therein, by all suitable and appropriate means.

Article III: Members

Section 1: Any member who pays the dues required by the Society shall be a member in good standing.

Section 2: Any member who resigns from, or no longer pays dues to Delta Daylily Society, Inc. has lost membership in the Society.

Article IV: Officers

Section 1: Officers

The officers of the Society shall be a president, a vice president, a secretary, a treasurer, and a scholarship treasurer.

Section 2: Nomination

Prior to the last meeting of his/her term, the president shall appoint a nominating committee of no fewer than three members who shall report at the meeting. It shall be the duty of this committee to nominate a candidate for each office to be filled. Before the election at the meeting, any additional nominations from the floor shall be permitted. A majority vote of the members present shall elect. The term of two calendar years for each newly elected officer shall begin on the following January. Officers may be re-elected to serve another term.

Section 3: Duties

a. President: The president shall preside at meetings, shall appoint the chairman of necessary committees, and assign appropriate tasks.

b. Vice President: The vice president shall develop programs for each meeting as required and in the absence of the president, shall fulfill duties as needed.

c. Secretary: The secretary shall record the business of each meeting and prepare a copy for the president and one for the permanent record.

d. Treasurer: The treasurer shall receive all dues and shall deposit all monies received into an appropriate account, shall make necessary payments, and shall provide information concerning dues paid and non-payment of dues.

e. Scholarship Treasurer: The scholarship treasurer shall receive all money donated to the scholarship fund and shall provide information concerning income interest and disbursement of funds according to the terms of the scholarship.

Article V: Meetings

Meetings shall be held at least four times per year. The time, place, date and object of each meeting shall be determined by the officers of the Society.

Article VI: Executive Committee

Section 1: All officers shall constitute the executive committee.

Section 2: The executive committee shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Society between its business meetings, fix the hour and place of meetings if necessary, make recommendations to the Society and shall perform other duties as specified by these bylaws. The executive committee shall be subject to the orders of the society, and none of its' acts shall conflict with action taken by the Society.

Article VII: Committees

The president shall appoint the chairman of all necessary standing committees. The members of each committee may be appointed by the president or by the chairman of that particular committee. The chairmen are to report as required.

Article VIII: Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of this association, the officers shall, after the payment or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of Delta Daylily Society, Inc., dispose of all the assets of this Society to the American Hemerocallis Society, Inc., which is a 501C(3) corporation.

Article IX: Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (1990 edition) shall govern the society in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are consistent with these bylaws and any special rules or order the Society may adopt.

Standing Rules

1. Dues are \$7.50 per year for one individual and \$10.00 for a family. Dues are payable to the treasurer by the September meeting date for the next calendar year. You may mail your dues to him/her prior to the meeting date or pay at the meeting.
2. At each meeting of the Society, each new member attending a Delta Daylily meeting for the first time as a Delta member will receive a one-year membership to the American Hemerocallis Society to be paid for by Delta Daylily Society. This does not apply to members who were previous Delta members and left the club for any reason.
